Dear Sandra Daussin, Esq.:

This responds to your citizen petition dated November 1, 2023, under docket number FDA-2023-P-4826 requesting that the Food and Drug Administration (FDA or we) set new temporary tolerances at the MDL for 30 PFAS in/on lettuce (head and leaf) and blueberries and for 26 PFAS in/on ready-to-eat bread, milk, eggs, salmon, clams, corn silage, and corn snaplage. Your petition also requested that these tolerances be lowered as methods improve and allow for lower validated MDLs.

We are advising you, in accordance with 21 CFR 10.30(e)(2), that we have not reached a decision on your petition within the first 180 days due to competing agency priorities. However, be advised that your petition is currently under active evaluation by our staff.
